I am writing to express my appreciation for the recent gift to Samaritan's Purse for hurricane relief. Your partnership with this ministry means so much.

We have approximately 100 staff on the ground in the Bahamas responding to the devastation left behind by Hurricane Dorian. Our Disaster Assistance Relief Team is distributing tons of shelter plastic, water filtration units, and other emergency supplies to people who are suffering. At the request of the Bahamian government and the World Health Organization, we have also deployed an Emergency Field Hospital to provide medical care to residents after the hospital in Freeport was severely damaged. Our teams are also responding on Ocracoke Island, North Carolina, as many homes were flooded.

Please pray for those whose lives have been turned upside down and for our teams as we help in Jesus' Name. We want people to know that they can put their trust in the Lord, who is "*a refuge for the needy in their distress, a shelter from the storm*" (Isaiah 25:4a). May God bless you.
